Jim Donahue – questioning the bill, Chelsea stated a bill was voided so its not usually that high. 7 accounts are paid on that bill, the bill usually ranges from \$700-\$1,100 monthly. Mr. Donahue was just questioning the cost because he wanted to make sure we were not scammed and having to pay an additional surcharge on the bill from a third-party company.

The Pavilion at Star Lakes, General Manager Enzo Carannante stopped in and wanted to thank the Township for support. Stating that there were 28 concerts last year with 9 sell outs for the 2023 concert season. The Pavilion is ranked 8th in top 100 outdoor amphitheaters worldwide. Mr. Michaels questioned that Supervisors getting pass to observe the officers working. Enzo stated that because of security they cannot have an all-access pass but to just let him know what concerts they would like to go to and he can't get a pass for them. The 2024 concert season has 11 shows on sale, as of now, and average around 20-30 shows a year.

Questioned how many citations have been issued to the resident for the house on Dillo Road. No Officers were at the meeting, however Mr. Handick stated he spoke with an officer did go out to the property, and stated he either didn't answer the door or was not home. Mr. Makel ask Chelsea to find out how many citations have been filed and what is going on. Chelsea is to then, email the supervisors and Mr. Makel and let them know what is going on with this incident.
